DRIVING DIRECTIONS

FROM ALBUQUERQUE AIRPORT TO THE BISHOP'S LODGE

About 1¼ to 1½ hour drive.

Anybody at the car rental desk will be able to direct you to I-25; it's very close to the airport. Take Highway I-25 north to Santa Fe. As you come into Santa Fe, take the third exit (#282), St. Francis Drive.

Drive north on St. Francis Drive (toward Espanola and Taos) about 3.7 miles, through 10 traffic lights to the 11th light at Paseo de Peralta. (Paseo de Peralta is a loop road which intersects twice with St. Francis Drive; you will need the second Paseo de Peralta, with the Bank of America on the north-east corner.)

Turn right on Paseo de Peralta, drive through 4 traffic lights to the 5th light at Washington Avenue (to Bishops Lodge Road). Turn left on to Washington Avenue. (The name of the street changes from Washington Avenue to Bishop's Lodge Road a couple of blocks after you turn.)

Drive 3.5 miles. The Bishop's Lodge is at the bottom of the hill, on the right.



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
