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Bishop's Lodge Resort Opens the SháNah Spa and Wellness Center

The spa's outdoor patio features dramatic sculptures by the late Native American artist Allan Houser.

Nestled in the foothills of the majestic Sangre de Cristo Mountains on more than 400 acres of land, Bishop's Lodge was founded by the first Bishop of Santa Fe in 1851. The historic resort attracts visitors year after year with expansive, natural surroundings, panoramic views and a wide variety of outdoor activities. Minutes from downtown Santa Fe, travelers enjoy convenience with serenity and security in this Southwestern mountain resort.

Bishop's Lodge features 111 distinctive guest accommodations set in 15 separate "lodges." Guestrooms have their own character ranging from New Mexican, Santa Fe and Spanish Colonial style. Many of the rooms connect and are suited for families. The resort recently completed their new presidential suite, a 2,000 square foot suite with two bedrooms, living room and state-of-the-art small meeting capabilities.

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
